

**KENILWORTH TO  
HOLD ELECTION**

**Taxpayers Ignore Wishes  
Of Officials And Mayor  
Gives In**

A municipal election will be held for the town of Kenilworth February 17, it was announced yesterday. Mayor James H. Caine called the election under a writ of peremptory mandamus granted a group of taxpayers some time ago.

This writ was granted by Judge Thomas J. Shaw in the Buncombe County Superior Court, but was appealed by the Kenilworth officials. The appeal was dismissed by the Supreme Court. It was pointed out that officials of the town believed that an election would be an unnecessary expense and it would be but a short time until the town would be included in the city of Asheville. The taxpayers desired the election, however.

C. N. Malone represented Kenilworth and Joe L. Deadwyler the taxpayers.
