

FIGHT ON NEGRO VOTES EXPECTED

Kenilworth Faction To Hold "Indignation" Meeting Tonight

Members of the Taxpayers' ticket, headed by B. W. Romefelt, candidate for Mayor, Town of Kenilworth, will hold an "indignation" meeting at the Forest Hill Inn tonight.

The paramount topic for consideration will be the discovery, it is alleged by members of the taxpayers tickets, that the Citizens' Ticket is preparing to vote a large block of negroes who were brought into the city in an extension of the city limits of Kenilworth at the last session of the legislature.

Other members of the Taxpayers' ticket are M. Zindel, A. H. Adams, and T. C. Harrell, for commissioner.

The members of the Citizens' ticket are Dr. C. P. Edwards for Mayor; G. O. Shepherd, Roscoe A. Marvel and Jack Faulkner.

According to the statements made yesterday by members of the Taxpayers' ticket they were non-plussed by the discovery of the annexation to Kenilworth of a negro community known as Brackettville. It has been alleged that the Citizens' ticket has registered and plans to vote a great number of these negroes, and it is to discuss this that the indignation meeting will be held.
